'CAN WE GET AN ENCORE Music: Mrs. Ihde

The 5th grade music classes are working on their music composition unit. They first wrote measures of music in traditional paper and pencil form, and then used the Garage Band app to mix instrument voices into a 16 measure original!

Students in 4th grade have been singing a song from the Netherlands entitled "Sarasponda." They have added the stick choreography that calls for them to tap in time to the song, and then exchange sticks with their partner while keeping the beat!

The 3rd grade music classes have been reinforcing their knowledge of 16th note patterns with a song entitled "Chicken on a Fencepost." We have added an obstacle course that students must maneuver while singing.

2nd graders are preparing for their music program next week, while 1st grade students are adding the solfegge hand signs to the songs they have been singing, including "Old Dog Full of Fleas" and "Bounce the Ball."

Kindergarten students are working on a call-response song entitled "Going on a Picnic," where they sing their response in groups of two. They are also having fun jumping the line to the beat of "Jump Rope Song!"
