The Activities Department would like to update you on new procedures. Those include; ticketing for home varsity football games, transportation for practices, athletic registration and our new website. Please take a moment to read through this very important information.

Ticket Purchasing - Varsity Football

In order to help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 we are partnering with Hometown Ticketing for individual ticket sales this year. This process will be used for our home varsity football games as it attracts our largest crowd. Individual ticket sales will be dispersed into five groups.

Group One

Parents of football players, cheerleaders and dancers. Four tickets will be allotted per family. A specified code will be sent out on Wednesday at 10:00 am and ticket sales will end at 5:00 pm the same day. The code will be sent out each Wednesday before a home football game. Unused tickets will default to general admission. Marching band parents will receive a separate communication on procedures prior to the first performance.

Group Two

Visitors, a specified code will be sent out on Wednesday at 10:00 am and ticket sales will end at 5:00 pm the same day.

Group Three

Students, a specified ticket code will be sent out to student emails on Wednesday night at 6 pm fifteen minutes apart by class seniority, until filled.

Group Four

Remaining stadium bleacher tickets will be available as general admission. A code will be released Thursday morning at 10:00 am.

Group Five

"The Mustang Pit" a code for this option will be available at 7:00 am on Friday of game day. The Mustang Pit will be closed once seating capacity has been met. To enjoy seating in The Mustang Pit, bring your lawn chair and sit in the high jump area, which is located on the northeast corner of the football stadium.

Staff passes will not be available this year. Staff will have the option to work the event for free entry or will need to purchase a general admission/Mustang Pit ticket.

Facial coverings are required for all fans while entering the gate and in public spaces. Once you get to your seat and are physically distanced you may remove your facial covering.

Transportation for Practice 7th Grade and Up

The Athletic and Transportation Departments have teamed together to offer shuttle busing for students learning in a Hybrid or Online Learning Model for students in grades seven and up. The shuttle service will not be offered to students on Wednesday. You can find the bus schedule for days that your child is not learning at school here.
